Dear Petersburg School District students and families,

Beginning March 23<sup>rd</sup> and lasting for the extent of the school closure, Petersburg Borough School District will be offering free meals for children 18 years of age or younger, and those 18 and older enrolled in high school. Homeschool students are also welcome to participate in this program.

On Monday, March 23, we will be offering breakfast and lunch as well as Tuesday's breakfast (3 meals to pick up at one time on the first day of service, March 23). Tuesday, March 24, we will provide lunch and Wednesday's breakfast and so forth throughout the week. On Friday, a child will receive lunch and Monday's breakfast. We will continue until school is back in session.

Please bring a bag to carry your meals and milk home safely. In the nature of grab and go, we will have many plastic fruit cups and wrappers. We encourage you to create art, plant seedlings, and share images of your creations with us.

These meals will be provided under the model of the Summer Food Service Program, with the following requirements:

- All children ages 1-18 will be served at any location listed above. Any student who is enrolled in school but is under the age of 21 may also participate.
- Children must be present in order to pick up a meal, in accordance with federal requirements.

- If students and children with food allergies plan to receive a meal, their parent and/or guardian/caregiver will need to RSVP Carlee Johnson-McIntosh at [cjohnson@pcsd.us](mailto:cjohnson@pcsd.us) or respond to the survey.
- Parents of students who are homebound, on 14-day quarantine, medically fragile, or who cannot otherwise access transportation to one of the approved locations should contact Carlee Johnson-McIntosh at [cjohnson@pcsd.us](mailto:cjohnson@pcsd.us) to organize meal drop-offs.
